Jonathan S. Jennings and Jacquelyn McPeak (Barczak) were part of the team that co-authored the American Bar Association's *amicus curiae* brief filed last week with the U.S. Supreme Court. Respondent in the case, *In re Tam*, challenges statutory restrictions on registering disparaging trademarks on First Amendment grounds. The ABA brief does not take a position on the central, constitutional question before the Court. Rather, it seeks to clarify certain trademark and unfair competition law principles that the ABA considers important for a fully informed analysis of the issue.
