The 2012 Pattishall Medal for Teaching Excellence has been awarded to David Vaver, Emeritus Fellow of St Peter's College and former Director of the Oxford Intellectual Property Research Centre. He was a member of the UK Intellectual Property Advisory Committee, and chaired the University's IP Advisory Group until he retired at the end of 2007. Vaver will be recognized at the INTA Gala, in Washington, DC, on May 5, 2012.
